Hiring a dental therapist is also a smart investment for private practice dentists looking to grow their practices while taking care of their community. And dental therapy increases access to jobs and quality dental care for people in underserved communities. The high cost of dental school puts it out of reach for many people from underserved communities but dental therapy shows that it's possible to build an accessible pathway to education that allows people from underserved communities to become the dental providers their communities need, while earning a good wage.
